



Talking Points for IUDs and Implants

IUDs and **Implants** can be used by most patients, including teens and those with no children. When patients call asking about IUDs or implants, please remember the following talking points:

IUDs are...

- ❖ Effective: One of the most effective options of contraception. IUDs (ParaGard, Mirena, and Liletta) are also the most effective form of emergency contraception.
- Low or No Hormones: One type of IUD has no hormones (ParaGard®), and the others have a low dose of hormone (Mirena®Liletta®Skyla® Kyleena®). IUDs do not contain estrogen.
- ❖ Safe: IUDs are safe, easy to remove, and they won't affect your ability to get pregnant in the future.
- Easy To Use: You don't have to remember to do anything for IUDs to work.
- Reversible: Fertility returns immediately after removal.
- Long-Lasting: IUDs can be used for up to 3-12 years, but you can request removal at any time, for any reason.

Implants are...

- Effective: One of the most effective options of contraception.
- Low Hormones: The Nexplanon® implant contains a low dose of hormone, which is released gradually over time. The implant does not contain estrogen.
- Safe: Implants are safe, easy to remove, and they won't affect your ability to get pregnant in the future.
- Easy To Use: You don't have to remember to do anything for the implant to work.
- Reversible: Fertility returns immediately after removal.
- Long Lasting: The implant can be used for up to 3-5 years, but you can request removal at any time, for any reason.
